TALK ABOUT IT - WEEKLY DISCUSSION

CONNECT THE DOTS COAT

WHAT YOU NEED: "Dot to Dot Coat" Activity Page (use crayons in challenge bag)

WHAT YOU DO:

Put your crayon on a dot and then draw a line from that dot to the next one. Connect the dots until it creates a picture. Color the page after you have connected the dots.

THINK ABOUT IT:

What did you create when you connected all the dots? Yes! It's a coat. Be sure to color your coat with a lot of different colors because that is what Joseph's coat looked like. His dad gave Joseph a beautiful coat of many colors!

DO IT - WEEKLY ACTIVITY

Next, here is a quick activity to do with someone in your family

SUNDAY SCOOP

WHAT YOU NEED: "The Scoop" Activity Page, 2 cotton balls, 1 red pom pom, glue stick, glitter glue

WHAT YOU DO:

Color the ice cream sundae on the activity page. Stretch out the cotton balls and glue them to the top of the ice cream so that it looks like whipped cream. Glue a red pom pom on the top of the cotton so that it looks like a cherry on top.

THINK ABOUT IT:

Do you like ice cream? Do you like ice cream sundaes? Did you read what it says on the ice cream sundae? Have a grownup help you read this very important message. It says, "God has... a Plan... for You!"

He does! God has a plan for you!

Remember, God had a very important plan for Joseph too. Joseph worked for a man named Potiphar and did whatever Potiphar told him to do. One day, somebody said Joseph did something very wrong! Joseph didn't do it, but he was put in jail! Joseph knew God loved him. And Joseph knew God was always with him. So, even though things were hard, Joseph trusted God's plan.

We can trust God even when things are hard because God loves us, Just like when he was with Joseph, God is with us, and God's got a plan for us! Say this out loud: "Who has a plan for you? God has a plan for me!"

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DO IT - WEEKLY ACTIVITY

Next, here is a quick activity to do with someone in your family

SWEET DREAMS

WHAT YOU NEED: No supplies needed.

WHAT YOU DO:

Play a game where you fall asleep and then wake up. When you wake up, talk about what you dreamed.

THINK ABOUT IT:

Let's play a fun game. Pretend to fall asleep and when you wake up, tell someone what you dreamed about. Take turns pretending to have silly dreams.

Pharaoh, the king of Egypt had some crazy dreams too. Do you know what he dreamed about? He dreamed about cows! Do you ever dream about cows? What does a cow say? MOOOOO!

He also dreamed about something else, do you know what it was? He dreamed about grain, which is what is used to make yummy bread. Pretend you are eating a delicious piece of bread. NOM-NOM-NOM!

Pharaoh didn't know what his dream about cows and grain meant, so he asked Joseph to help him. Joseph told Pharaoh that his dreams were from God. God wanted him to start saving lots of grain so all the people would have enough food to eat later. Pharaoh was so happy that he put Joseph in charge of all of Egypt so he could help save the grain. Everything happened just like Joseph said because he had trusted God's plan.

Next, here is a quick activity to do with someone in your family

MEMORY MATCH

WHAT YOU NEED: "Memory Match" Activity Page

WHAT YOU DO:

Find someone to play this fun memory matching game. Place all the cards on the floor or table, face down. Take turns choosing two cards and turning them over. If they match, remove both cards and set them aside. If they don't match, turn both of the cards back over in the same place. In both cases, have the next person take a turn. Repeat until all of the matches have been made.

THINK ABOUT IT:

This fun memory match is all about the story of Joseph! Did you find the match of when Joseph went to jail? Even though he was in jail, he was still a good helper. Did you find the match of when Joseph got his special coat from his father? What about the match when Joseph helped Pharaoh understand his dreams? Last of all, did you find the match about when Joseph decided to forgive his brother and give them food?

Joseph's brothers did a terrible thing to Joseph. However, it was God's plan for Joseph to forgive them. His brothers were hungry and needed food and Joseph helped them. You can always trust that God has a plan for you.
