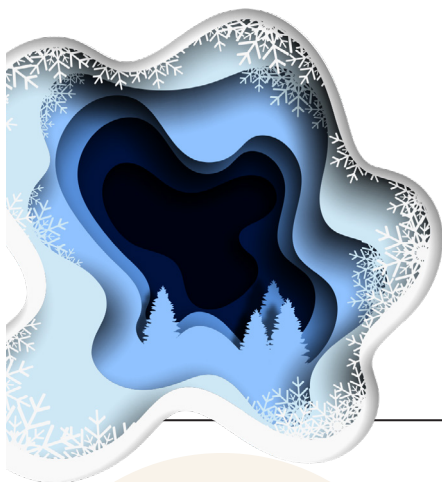

What are you giving this Christmas?

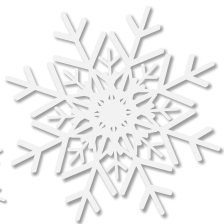
Week Four
