### PRE-CAMP CHECK-IN

- June 26 at 5p in the Student Center. Please bring all applicable items to help expedite the departure process:

## CAMP RULES

### FOUR BASIC RULES FOR CAMP

- RESPECT CAMP PROPERTY Let's leave the campus better than we found it.
- RESPECT LEADERS Your leader and all other adults leading at camp.
- RESPECT YOUR PEERS Help make the week fun for everyone.
- NO "PURPLE" No one girl/one guy alone or PDA; always be with a buddy from your tribe.

### THREE MANDATORY EXPERIENCES FOR EVERY CAMPER

- MEETINGS Campers must attend all meetings/sessions on the schedule.
- MEDS Campers with meds must take required doses at required times.
- MEALS You gotta eat!

#### **ENFORCEMENT**

While we want every camper to fully enjoy his/her experience while at camp, occasionally we have to enforce consequences when youth push the boundaries of these rules.

## Campers who break these rules will face the following:

- FIRST OFFENSE Warning: Everyone deserves a second chance.
- SECOND OFFENSE Camper will sit out from that specific activity.
- THIRD OFFENSE Parents will be called to discuss situations and may be asked to come get their child depending on the severity of the offense.



# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### **HOW ARE YOU GETTING TO CAMP?**

 Transportation will be by chartered bus. Please do not plan to drop off/pick up your student at camp unless there is some special need. We cannot offer discounts if students don't ride the bus.

#### ARE MY KIDS GOING TO BE SAFE?

• Of course they are! We have an incredible ratio of 1 adult leader to every 6-8 youth. Our staff and leaders have been hand selected, background checked and trained to work with youth. We take safety seriously so you can rest at ease.

### WHO WILL BE IN MY CHILD'S TRIBE?

• Tribes are divided by grade and gender. Most grade/genders are made up of multiple Tribes (i.e. there are two 9th grade girls groups). For the most part, campers are grouped with kids and Tribe leaders they see each Sunday.

### CAN YOU ACCOMMODATE FOOD ALLERGIES?

 Yes! In the registration process, all of your student's allergies were taken, and we have communicated those allergies to the camp kitchen to accommodate those students who need it.

## WILL MY CHILD GET ANY SLEEP?

• Yes, but probably not as much as they would at home. Let's just put it this way - they'll probably be ready for bed early on Friday!

## WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Drugs/tobacco (including vapes/e-cigarettes)
- Alcohol
- Weapons
- No clothing advertising alcohol, tobacco, drugs or suggestive sayings
- No spaghetti straps, low cut tops or "short" shorts.

\*\*If clothing is deemed inappropriate, campers will be required to change.

## **CELL PHONES**

We do allow our youth to carry their cell phones; however it is not to be excessively used.
 Phones are not to be used for constant social media, or during any small group and large group sessions. Tribe leaders will be enforcing this expectation.

## **MEDICATIONS**

All medication MUST BE checked in to our staff at PRE-CAMP CHECK IN ON JUNE 26.
 This includes any over-the-counter medication and/or supplements. Medication will be dispensed by the Camp Nurse/Leader, and campers will not be allowed to keep any medication with them.



## EXTRA FOOD + DRINK

There will be optional snack and drink shops open during free/recreational times during camp. So if your student gets extra hungry, they'll be ready to fill their stomach!
